Memorial Day is a time to honor and remember the brave men and women who sacrificed their lives while serving in the U.S. military. This weekend, many of us will observe Memorial Day by visiting cemeteries and memorials, gathering with family, and enjoying outdoor activities.

Veterans Memorial Park in Clarksburg is an ideal destination to spend Memorial Day weekend. This 50-acre park not only honors fallen service members with monuments and reflection areas but also offers a variety of recreational activities. The park surrounds the Louis A. Johnson VA Medical Center and features six picnic shelters, a 1.5-mile walking trail, baseball fields, accessible play structures, a dog park, a boat launch, and a fishing dock. Additionally, the park is home to the Splash Zone Water Park, River Bend Mini Golf, and the Clarksburg Amphitheater.

Recently, the Friends of Clarksburg Parks Foundation unveiled a new veterans monument near the park entrance, across from the Freedom Shelter pavilion and Clarksburg Splash Zone, offering easily accessibility to the public. "Memorial Day weekend is a huge weekend for us here in Clarksburg," said Doug Comer, director of City Parks of Clarksburg. "We have two
